REUSABLE SANITARY PRODUCTS REBATE



Terms and Conditions

- The rebate includes sanitary pads, sanitary cups, leak-proof underwear and wet bags.
- The rebate does not include transport costs, postage/delivery or single-use items.
- The applicant must be the occupant of the property requesting the rebate.
- The applicant must provide a proof of residence of the City of Bunbury e.g. utility bill, concession card, pension card, drivers licence, rates notice.
- City of Bunbury will accept only one application for each rebate per house household for an indefinite period. If more than one eligible application is received from different eligible applicants with the same residential address, the first of those applications received by the City of Bunbury will prevail.
- The applicant must provide a copy of the receipt or proof of purchase. It must include the date, and clear identification of name and cost of each item purchased.
- If multiple items are purchased, rebated items must be underline on the receipt.
- Receipt or proof of purchase must be no older than 6 months from start date 1st July 2022.
- Incomplete applicants will not be processed. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the application is complete in full. The City of Bunbury holds the right to reject any application
- The rebate program may be paused at any time if budget allocations have been exhausted.
- The City of Bunbury may take up to 30 days from receipt of an eligible application to process that application. Each application will be assessed and successful applicants will be notified by email.
- Payment will be made via EFT to the bank account nominated by the applicant within 30 days of notification that their application has been successful.



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
