Instructions:

Set up an account and add your credit card to easily pay for parking with the Park Bunbury app.

Once you have logged in, follow the below instructions.

1. Tap the coloured icon showing where you have parked.
2. Select the area you have parked in, in order to select the correct bay.
3. Choose Park/Pay at the bottom of the screen.
Note: You must be logged in as a registered user to see Park/Pay. Guests or non-registered users cannot see this option. Park/Pay will only appear in carparks where a fee is payable.
4. Select or input your bay number (e.g. 54) - you can find it painted on the space where you have parked.
5. Select the amount of time you wish to pay for.
6. Follow the instructions in the app to choose your vehicle registration and credit card details, and then pay.
7. Once you have paid, you will see the timer screen and you will receive an email receipt.

The City offers four parking options – free all-day carpark, shopper carparks which offer three hours free with the option to pay for longer, free on-street parking with time limits or paid all-day carparks.

Parking Information

- All car bays have in-ground sensors – if you're planning on staying for only the free allotted time, you don't need to do anything, just park and walk to your destination (including in the shopper carparks).
- If you want to pay for additional time or all-day parking in the longer-term carparks, input your car bay at one of the pay-by-bay parking meters and use payWave to purchase extra time.
- OR, the City also has an app called Park Bunbury which can be used to pay for parking where needed.
- ACROD and TPI permit holders can park in any City car bay for double the duration of any time limit – a valid ACROD or TPI permit must be displayed.
- The Centrepont Shopping Centre carparks are not managed by the City and have different parking times/directions.
