

Annual General Meeting of Electors – Motions

Electors who wish to give notice of a motion to be moved at the Annual General Meeting of Electors can do so by submitting this form to the City by either:

Electors who have given notice of motions prior to the meeting will be called to move their motion/s in the order the motions were received. The Mayor will call for a seconder to each motion.

The Mayor will call on the mover and seconder to speak to the motion, followed by any other speakers that may wish to speak. At the end of debate, the motion will be put to the vote. All City of Bunbury Electors present at the meeting will be able to vote on any motions.

Decisions made by Electors at an Annual Electors Meeting are presented to a meeting of Council for consideration per Section 5.33 of the *Local Government Act 1995*, which reads"

"All decisions made at an electors' meeting are to be considered at the next Ordinary Council Meeting or, if that is not practicable, at the first Ordinary Council Meeting after that meeting or at a special meeting called for that purpose, whichever happens first."
