The Setagaya Goodwill Tour was formed out of the Sister City relationship with Setagaya which was signed in 1992 by Bunbury Mayor Ernest Manea and Setagaya Mayor Oba.

The program has run every year since, with the aim to develop leadership skills by empowering students to represent Bunbury positively, strengthening the sister-city relationship, fostering mutual cultural understanding, and building lasting connections between both cities.

The Tour runs during the September school holidays and is led by a City of Bunbury representative. Up to 16 students from Years 6 and 7 - and three accompanying adults - will be accepted into the program.

- Visiting Hakone and viewing Mt Fuji
- A homestay with a Japanese family
- Visiting Tokyo Disneyland

Should you wish to apply to be a part of this year's tour, please submit your online application via the relevant SmartyGrants links below. Following your application, you will need to make a \$750 deposit to the City of Bunbury.

- The Tour will take place from Sunday, 28 September to Thursday, 9 October 2025.
- Approximate costs are \$4,480 \$4,980 per person, depending on the applicant's age.
- The tour cost covers all expenses including: flights, accommodation, meals, entry fees and spending money.
- Customary gifts for your host family will need to be created or bought yourself.
