

# City of Bunbury Hands Oval Venue Entry Conditions – AFL 2025 Season

## General Conditions of Entry

The following Conditions of Entry apply to all patrons (Patron(s)) attending major events at the City of Bunbury Hands Oval. These Conditions of Entry are to be read in conjunction with the conditions of entry that may apply to:

1. A specific event (Event Conditions, refer to the event page).
2. The ticketing agent's terms and conditions of ticket sale (Ticket Conditions, refer to the relevant website).
3. Specific conditions of sports governing bodies (Specific Conditions, refer below).

Each of these conditions may include additional terms to those set out in these Conditions of Entry.

## Specific Conditions for Sports Events

- AFL – Conditions of Entry will apply for each event of the Australian Football League (AFL) matches.
- Specific Conditions will be available from the website of the respective sport's governing bodies.

Patrons who fail to comply with the Conditions of Entry, Event Conditions, Ticket Conditions, and/or Specific Conditions may be refused entry or removed from the City of Bunbury Hands Oval without refund or compensation under any circumstances.

The City of Bunbury Hands Oval reserves the right to update, modify, or change these Conditions of Entry from time to time. Any changes will be posted and available at the entry points to the venue. Each ticketing agent and sports governing body reserves the right to update, modify, or change the Ticket Conditions or Specific Conditions (as applicable), and changes will be posted and available on the applicable website.

## Refusal of Entry

The City of Bunbury Hands Oval reserves the right to refuse entry to any:

- Patron deemed intoxicated, drug-affected, disorderly, threatening, or abusive;
- Unauthorised Patron;
- Patron carrying items that may compromise safety or cause injury or nuisance;
- Patron not holding a valid ticket, including tickets purchased from unauthorised sources or scalpers, or those that appear defaced, forged, or copied;
- Patron who refuses to submit their belongings for inspection or to be checked.

### **General Conditions**

- The City of Bunbury Hands Oval reserves the right to inspect and search bags of all Patrons entering or exiting the venue.
- The City of Bunbury Hands Oval reserves the right to conduct personal checks of all Patrons, which may include pat-down searches or wandering.
- Patrons must not attempt to conceal their identity, either at the point of entry or while inside the venue.
- The wearing of 'colours' or insignia belonging to outlaw motorcycle clubs (OMCs) or other prohibited groups is prohibited.
- Patrons displaying inappropriate or unauthorised commercial, political, religious, or offensive logos or messages may be denied entry or asked to remove such items.
- Patrons who gain unauthorised access to restricted areas or the playing field may be evicted and face penalties, including imprisonment or fines.
- Patrons who cause disturbances, become intoxicated, or refuse to comply with staff directions will be evicted from the venue.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (16 years or older) and must remain with them at all times.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted within the City of Bunbury Hands Oval.
- Patrons bring personal items into the venue at their own risk. The venue is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- Soliciting or customer surveying is not permitted within the venue.
- Throwing objects within the venue is prohibited. Patrons caught throwing objects will be evicted.

### **Restricted/Prohibited Items**

Patrons are not permitted to bring the following restricted/prohibited items into the venue:

- Umbrellas
- Strollers and prams
- Glassware, glass bottles or cans, including spray cans
- Alcoholic beverages
- Illegal substances, including illegal drugs
- Flares, fireworks, weapons, explosives, or smoke bombs
- Laser pointers
- Knives or other dangerous weapons
- Pets or animals (other than assistance dogs)

- Folding chairs or stools
- Cameras or recording devices (for commercial purposes) including tripods
- Remote control vehicles, drones, or similar devices
- Oversized banners or flags
- Musical instruments or noise makers (whistles, horns, drums, vuvuzelas)
- Confetti or shredded paper
- Balloons or other inflatable items
- Scooters, roller skates, skateboards, or bicycles
- No unsealed water / liquid bottles allowed
- Bag sizes limited to 30cm x 40cm
- No Eskies will be permitted (Small over-shoulder soft-cooler bags acceptable providing they meet bag size limits)

No cloakng facilities at the venue

Patrons arriving with prohibited items will be asked to return them to their vehicle or leave outside the venue at their own risk.

### **Alcohol & Illegal Drugs**

- Alcoholic beverages cannot be brought into or removed from the venue.
- Intoxicated or drug-affected Patrons will not be permitted entry or may be evicted.
- Patrons in possession of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be permitted entry and may be evicted if found in possession.

### **Dress Standards**

- Patrons must be appropriately clothed for a public place and must wear shoes. Patrons with bare feet will not be permitted entry.

### **Compliance**

Compliance with these conditions is mandatory to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all patrons.
